**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to  
Original House Bill No. 462 by Representative Mincey

**1** AMENDMENT NO. 1**2** On page 1, line 3, after "minor" delete the remainder of the line and insert "from a school,  
**3** child day care center, or early learning center; to provide for definitions; to provide for  
**4** criminal penalties; to"**5** AMENDMENT NO. 2**6** On page 1, line 7, after "school" insert a comma "," and insert "child day care center, or early  
**7** learning center"**8** AMENDMENT NO. 3**9** On page 1, delete lines 8 through 14 in their entirety and insert the following:**10** "A. It shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly and intentionally  
**11** remove a minor from a school, child day care center, or early learning center when  
**12** such person is not authorized to do so, including a parent otherwise prohibited from  
**13** removing the child from a school, child day care center, or early learning center by  
**14** an order of a court of competent jurisdiction.**15** B. Whoever violates the provisions of Subsection A of this Section shall:  
**16** (1) On a first or second offense, be fined not more than one thousand dollars,  
**17** imprisoned for not more than six months, or both.**18** (2) On a third or subsequent offense, be fined not more than five thousand  
**19** dollars, imprisoned with or without hard labor for not less than five years, or both."**20** AMENDMENT NO. 4**21** On page 1, line 15, after "a" and before "who" change "student" to "minor"**22** AMENDMENT NO. 5**23** On page 1, delete line 16 in its entirety and insert the following:**24** "school, child day care center, or early learning center for a sponsored function by  
**25** the school, child day care center, or early learning center."**26** AMENDMENT NO. 6**27** On page 1, after line 16, add the following:**28** "D. The provisions of Paragraph (1) of Subsection B of this Section shall  
**29** only be enforced by the use of summons in lieu of custodial arrest, in accordance  
**30** with Code of Criminal Procedure Article 211.**31** E. As used in this Section:**32** (1) "School" has the same meaning as in R.S. 14:95.6.**33** (2) "Child day care center" and "early learning center" have the same  
**34** meaning as in R.S. 17:407.33."
