EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. The proposed law allows law enforcement agencies to issue electronic citation forms. The Department of Public Safety, Office of Motor Vehicles (OMV) reports that under this measure a Notice of Suspension (Driving Under Suspension) and a Notice of Violations (Driving Without Compulsory Insurance) are two physical forms that can be sent electronically. Since the proposed law does not mandate the use of electronic citation forms, it does not have a fiscal impact on law enforcement agencies that cannot submit electronic citation forms. Those agencies will continue to utilize paper citation forms.
