AN ACT

To enact R.S. 49:170.8, relative to state symbols; to provide that mayhaw jelly is the official state jelly of Louisiana; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 49:170.8 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§170.8. State jelly

There shall be an official state jelly. The official state jelly shall be the mayhaw jelly. Its use on official documents of the state and with the insignia of the state is hereby authorized.
