A RESOLUTION

To declare Wednesday, June 4, 2008, Military Family Day in the Louisiana Senate in honor of America's military personnel, and in particular, in honor of Louisiana's fallen heroes.

WHEREAS, Louisiana has provided significant military manpower in America's war on terrorism; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana sent the 256th Infantry Brigade, one of the premier national guard units in America, to Operation Iraqi Freedom, where they served with great distinction, dedication, and courage; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana continues to send its individual armed forces personnel and national guard units to the Iraqi Theater and into harm's way; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana has participated heavily in Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan, sending assets, both personal and material, to stop the terrorist threat posed there by those who would harm America and her people; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana has a proud tradition of active participation in each of this country's fights for freedom, the many battles for liberty and unending struggle for democracy; and

WHEREAS, the anniversary of two major military events will occur near June 4, 2008, the Memorial Day remembrance of those killed in war and the 64th anniversary of the D-Day landings in Normandy, where Louisiana-produced landing craft made the allied victory possible; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Senate has recognized and praised those who serve and has honored each of its fallen soldiers with a Condolence Resolution so that no one will ever forget their service and sacrifice in the war on terrorism, in Iraq, Afghanistan, and elsewhere; and

WHEREAS, it is entirely appropriate that the upper chamber of the Louisiana Legislature extends an invitation to the families of those who serve and of those who have fallen to be the guests of the state of Louisiana and the Senate for a day of recognition and honor.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby declare Wednesday, June 4, 2008, Military Family Day in the Senate in order to honor all American military personnel, and in particular to honor Louisiana's fallen soldiers and their families.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to each family represented in the ceremony.
