# ACT No. 271

HOUSE BILL NO. 356

BY REPRESENTATIVE GALLOT

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 11:2175(E)(3), relative to the Sheriffs' Pension and Relief Fund;  
3 to provide for recalculation of benefits and restoration of service credit for certain  
4 rehired retirees; to provide for repayment of benefits to the system upon  
5 reemployment; to provide eligibility requirements for recalculation of benefits and  
6 restoration of service credit; and to provide for related matters.

7 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published  
8 as provided by Article X, Section 29(C) of the Constitution  
9 of Louisiana.

10 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

11 Section 1. R.S. 11:2175(E)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

12 §2175. Blanket fidelity insurance policy; powers of board; rehired retirees; refund  
13 of contributions; restrictions on payments; warrants; deposits; investments

17 (3)(a) Upon subsequent retirement, the suspended retirement allowance shall  
18 be restored to full force and effect. In addition, the retirement allowance shall be  
19 increased by an amount attributable to the service and average compensation during  
20 reemployment based on the computation formula in effect at the time of subsequent  
21 retirement. Any supplemental benefit shall be based on reemployment compensation  
22 and service credit only, except the years of reemployment service shall be added to  
23 the member's original retirement service credit to determine the supplemental service  
24 credit accrual rate for purposes of computing any supplemental benefit earned during  
25 reemployment. No change in the retirement option selected by the member shall be

1 permitted as to the original retirement. However, the member shall be permitted to  
2 select any option authorized at the time of a second retirement as to any  
3 supplemental benefits earned by virtue of reemployment.

4 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any retiree  
5 who returns to work full time for a minimum of three years as an active contributing  
6 member of the fund may choose to have his benefits recalculated by repaying all  
7 retirement benefits received from the fund, plus interest at the board-approved  
8 actuarial valuation rate. This Subparagraph shall apply only to members that have  
9 returned to work not later than December 31, 2008. Required payments shall be paid  
10 in one lump-sum payment prior to subsequent retirement in order to be eligible for  
11 a recalculation as provided in this Subparagraph. Upon repayment of the required  
12 amount, the member shall have restored all service credit earned and shall be subject  
13 to the provisions of law that would have otherwise been applicable had he not  
14 previously retired for the purposes of calculation of retirement benefits. This  
15 Subparagraph shall not affect the provisions of Paragraph (6) of this Subsection  
16 applicable to members that are currently eligible for recalculation of benefits.

18 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
19 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
20 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
21 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
22 effective on the day following such approval.
