DIGEST

Formally recognizes the Isle de Jean Charles Band of the Biloxi-Chitimacha Confederation of Muskogeans ("BCCM"), the Bayou Lafourche Band of the BCCM, the Grand Caillou/Dulac Band of the BCCM, known collectively as the "BCCM Tribes" and the Pointe-au-Chien Indian Tribe for the sole purpose of qualifying for Indian education and health care benefits due these Native American citizens by the Legislature of Louisiana.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs to the original bill.

1. Reaffirms the Indian ancestry of four individual tribes for the sole purpose of education and healthcare benefits due to those Native American citizens.
2. Deletes the recognition by the U.S. Congress and U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs.
