Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to Engrossed House Bill No. 1321 by Representative K. Carter

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 16 delete "environmental exposures" and insert "environmental
3 factors, including physical, chemical, biological, and social factors"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 17 delete "prevalence and determinants of chronic diseases"
6 and insert "disease trends and research"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 2, delete lines 4 and 5 and insert "(1) To track and evaluate
9 environmental factors, including physical, chemical, biological, and social
10 factors, that may play a role in the development of certain chronic diseases."

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 2, delete lines 6 through 8 and insert "(2) To develop data in a
13 standardized format for optimal use with other public health databases and to
14 allow government, university, and public health officials to develop
15 hypotheses for research on the potential impact of environmental factors on
16 chronic diseases."

17 AMENDMENT NO. 5

18 On page 2, delete line 17 and insert "experts in epidemiology, public health,
19 and environmental health"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 6

21 On page 2, delete line 18 and on line 19 delete "populations to environmental
22 hazards"

23 AMENDMENT NO. 7

24 On page 3, line 7 delete "environment " and insert "physical, chemical,
25 biological, and socioeconomic environment"
