## DIGEST

Present law created the Concord Estates Crime Prevention District within the parish of East Baton Rouge.

Present law provides for the collection of an annual parcel fee within the district after a majority of the registered voters of the district have adopted a resolution by the governing authority. Further provides that the fee shall not exceed \$25.00.

Proposed law raises the limit of the parcel fee from not to exceed \$25.00 to not to exceed \$150.00.

Present law provides that the fee shall expire four years from its initial levy, but may be renewed. Also provides that the term of the imposition of the fee shall be as stated in a proposition authorizing such renewal not to exceed 4 years.

Proposed law changes the renewal term from not to exceed 4 years to not to exceed 10 years.

Effective August 15, 2009.
