DIGEST

Present law provides that the Louisiana Real Estate Commission consists of nine members appointed by the governor. Present law provides that one member is to be appointed from each of the seven supreme court districts and two members are to be appointed at large.

Proposed law changes the number of at-large members on the commission from two to four. Proposed law otherwise retains present law.

Present law provides that effective the second Monday in January 1992, appointees to the commission serve staggered terms of two, four, or six years, and that upon expiration of these initial terms, all appointees will serve six year terms. Proposed law deletes references to these initial staggered terms and provides that each appointee to the commission will serve only one six-year term. Proposed law otherwise retains present law.
