## DIGEST

Present law provides that, for properties within Orleans parish and under the jurisdiction of the New Orleans Sewerage and Water Board, any person who has laid mains, pipes, or conduits, or constructed any railroads, buildings, works, or structures of any kind in, on, or over the public streets, roads, drainage systems or canals, sewerage systems, or water systems may be compelled at his own cost and expense to shift or adjust any such mains, pipes, conduits, or structures to the exigencies of the public sewerage and public water and drainage systems.

Proposed law adds to present law list of persons who may be compelled at their own expense to shift or adjust their property persons who have laid high voltage electric lines, telecommunication, fiber optic, or other transmission wires.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
