DIGEST

Present law provides that notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, sparkling wine or still wine may be sold and shipped directly to a consumer in Louisiana by the manufacturer or retailer of such beverage domiciled outside of Louisiana, or by a wine producer domiciled inside or outside of Louisiana, provided that certain conditions are met.

Proposed law deletes the authority of such retailer to sell and ship sparkling wine or still wine to a consumer in Louisiana.

Effective August 15, 2009.
