DIGEST

Proposed law criminalizes operating a vehicle while under suspension for certain prior offenses.

Proposed law provides that whoever commits the crime of operating a vehicle while under suspension for certain prior offenses will be imprisoned for not less than 30 days nor more than six months without benefit of suspension of imposition or execution of sentence.

Proposed law provides that when the operator's driving privileges were suspended for vehicular homicide or first degree vehicular negligent injuring, the offender will be imprisoned for not less than 60 days nor more than six months without benefit of suspension of imposition or execution of sentence

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
