COASTAL PROTECT/RES AUTH. Provides relative to Louisiana Coastal Protection, Conservation, Restoration and Management. (8/15/09)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 49:213.4(A)(9), relative to Louisiana Coastal Protection, Conservation,

3 Restoration and Management; to provide for certain powers and duties of the Coastal

4 Protection and Restoration Authority; to authorize the authority to enter into certain

5 agreements with parish governing authorities; to provide certain terms and

6 conditions of the agreements; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 49:213.4(A)(9) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 §213.4. Powers and duties

10 A. The authority shall:

11 \* \* \*

12 **(9) Have the power to enter into any agreement with a parish governing**

13 **authority located wholly or partially within the coastal area but which is not**

14 **part of a levee district for the construction, operation, maintenance, repair,**

15 **rehabilitation, or replacement of any coastal protection, conservation and**

16 **restoration, hurricane protection, infrastructure, storm damage reduction, or**

17 **flood control project. The authority shall have the power to provide in the**
