Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

ENVIRONMENT/FEES: Repeals provisions relative to the handling of sulphur

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AN ACT

To repeal R.S. 30:2014(A)(3), relative to permits, licenses, registrations, variances, or compliance schedules granted by the Department of Environmental Quality; to repeal the prohibition on granting a permit, license, registration, variance, or compliance schedule to construct or modify certain facilities handling sulphur in a solid state.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 30:2014(A)(3) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**Abstract:** Repeals the prohibition on granting a permit, license, registration, variance, or compliance schedule to certain facilities receiving sulphur in solid state.

Present law prohibits a permit, license, registration, variance, or compliance schedule to be granted for the construction or modification of any facility to be used in receiving sulphur in the solid state in bulk quantities and from which sulphur particulate matter will be emitted.

Proposed law repeals present law.
