**HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by Representative Montoucet to Engrossed House Bill No. 688 by Representative Montoucet

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, after "penalties;" and before "and" insert "to provide for exceptions;"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, delete line 9 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

5 "any act upon the premises of a school, by a person who is not authorized to  
 6 be present on school premises, which would foreseeably cause any of the"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, between lines 15 and 16 insert the following:

9 "(1) "Authorized to be present on school premises" means any student or  
 10 teacher of the school as well as any other person who has authorization to be present  
 11 on the school premises from the principal of the school in the case of a public school,  
 12 or the principal or headmaster in the case of a nonpublic school."

13 AMENDMENT NO. 4

14 On page 1, at the beginning of line 16, change "(1)" to "(2)"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 5

16 On page 1, between lines 18 and 19 insert the following:

17 (3) "School premises" means any property used for school purposes,  
 18 including but not limited to school buildings, playgrounds, and parking lots.

19 AMENDMENT NO. 6

20 On page 1, at the beginning of line 19 change "(2)" to "(4)"

21 AMENDMENT NO. 7

22 On page 2, at the beginning of line 1, change "(3)" to "(5)"

23 AMENDMENT NO. 8

24 On page 2, line 6, after "of" delete the remainder of the line and insert "unlawful disruption  
 25 of the operation of a school shall be"

26 AMENDMENT NO. 9

27 On page 2, after line 8, insert the following:

1           "D. Nothing herein shall be construed to prevent lawful assembly and  
2 orderly petition for the redress of grievances, including any labor dispute between  
3 any school or institution of higher learning and its employees, or contractor or  
4 subcontractor or any employees thereof. Nothing herein shall apply to a bona fide  
5 labor organization or its legal activities such as picketing, assembly or concerted  
6 activities in the interest of its members for the purpose of securing better wages,  
7 hours, or working conditions."
