Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

DISTRICT ATTORNEYS RET. Provides for the membership of the District Attorneys' Retirement System. (7/1/09)

1 AN ACT
2 To repeal R.S. 11:1601(3)(b), relative to district attorneys; to provide for eligibility into the
3 District Attorneys' Retirement System; to remove certain prohibitions; and to provide
4 for related matters.
5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7 Section 1. R.S. 11:1601(3)(b) is hereby repealed in its entirety.
8 Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall apply to any person who took office on or after
9 November 15, 2008. To receive credit for the service rendered before July 1, 2009, the
10 person and his employer shall pay to the system the contributions that would have been paid
11 had membership in the system begun on the day the person first began employment covered
12 by the system.
13 Section 3. This Act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

DIGEST

Chaisson (SB 20)

Present law prohibits elected or appointed state or parish officials who have retired from any public retirement system from eligibility as a member of the District Attorneys' Retirement System.

Proposed law repeals (removes) the prohibition in present law.

Effective July 1, 2009.

(Repeals R.S. 11:1601(3)(b))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill.

1. Allows persons who took office on or after November 15, 2008 to receive credit for service rendered before effective date.
2. Establish effective date for legislation.
