HB No. 558

Abstract: Authorizes the municipalities in Jefferson Parish to dispose of certain immovable property.

Present law authorizes the governing authority of any parish having a population in excess of 325,000 persons, the parish of Orleans excepted, to dispose of immovable property owned by the parish or property to which the title is in the public, including but without limitation, streets, roads, and alleys, that is no longer needed for public use. Provides that the provisions of present law shall also apply to St. Tammany Parish and the city of Slidell. Provides further with respect to the method of disposition.

Proposed law retains present law and additionally authorizes the municipalities in Jefferson Parish to dispose of any such property.
