HB No. 771

Abstract: Authorizes the LCTCS board to set a uniform tuition amount for all online courses offered by institutions under its jurisdiction.

Present law provides relative to the Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges, including establishment, membership, meetings, officers, employees, and required functions.

Proposed law adds authority for the board to equalize the tuition amount for online courses offered by institutions under its jurisdiction by setting a uniform tuition amount for each online course in an amount up to the highest amount authorized by law for such courses in effect on the effective date of proposed law. Provides that such uniform tuition amount shall not be raised unless authorized by law.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Education to the original bill.

1. Provides that the authorized tuition amount for each online course shall be in an amount up to the highest amount authorized as provided in proposed law instead of an amount equal to the highest amount authorized.
