Purpose of Bill: Creates the Lincoln Parish Geographic information Systems District and provides for related matters.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on local fund expenditures as a result of this measure.

According to an official with Lincoln Parish, this district has been operational since 1993 as a cooperative endeavor between seven Lincoln Parish government agencies and is funded by those agencies based on the terms set forth in the cooperative endeavor agreement.

If the district were to choose to levy either the ad valorem or the sales and use taxes, (See Revenue Explanation below) expenditures would increase for the cost of holding the election.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.

The proposed bill provides authority for the district to levy an ad valorem tax and to levy a 1% sales and use tax, but the taxes would have to be approved by a majority of the voters in the district.
