LEVEES/TERREBONNE: Repeals the requirement of a distribution of a certain amount of millage revenues to the Atchafalaya Basin Levee District

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R. S. 38:291(U)(1) and 329(J)(introductory paragraph) and to repeal
3 R.S. 38:329(H), relative to the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District, to
4 provide for millages collected in Terrebonne Parish; to revert certain land in the
5 possession of the Atchafalaya Basin Levee District for certain purposes to the
6 Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District; to repeal certain required distribution
7 amounts; and to provide for related matters.

8 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
9 as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
10 Louisiana.

11 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

12 Section 1. R.S. 38:291(U)(1) and 329(J)(introductory paragraph) are hereby
13 amended and reenacted to read as follows:

14 §291. Naming; limits of districts; composition of boards

15 * * *

16 U. Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District. (1) On July 1, 1997, and
17 continuing thereafter, all lands in the parish of Terrebonne shall constitute a levee
18 district to be known as the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District. These lands
19 and all property thereon situated, not exempt from taxation, shall be subject to the
20 provisions of this Chapter. That these lands in the possession of the Atchafalaya

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to the original bill.

1. Stipulates that all land in the possession of the Atchafalaya Basin Levee District in Terrebonne Parish for the purposes of ownership and maintenance and operation of the Atchafalaya Basin Levee District be reverted back to the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District.
