DIGEST

Riser (SB 168)

Present law requires that all front seat occupants of a passenger car, van, or truck having a gross weight of 10,000 pounds or less, shall have a seat belt fastened when the vehicle is moving forward.

Present law provides special child passenger restraint systems for children under the age of thirteen.

Proposed law provides that all occupants of a passenger car, van, or truck having a gross weight of 10,000 pounds or less who are age 13 or older shall have a seat belt fastened when the vehicle is moving forward.

Effective August 15, 2009.
