Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs to Original Senate Bill No. 268 by Senator Donahue

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, delete "prevailing party"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 2, line 13, after "**equal to**" insert "**one hundred twenty-five percent of**"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 3, line 10, change "**(d)**" to "**D.**"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 3, line 15, delete "**prevailing party**"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 5

10 On page 3, line 17, change "Sub-title" to "**Title**"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 6

12 On page 3, line 18, after "under this" delete the remainder of the line, and delete lines 19  
13 through 29, and insert:

14 **"Title.** If any taxes, penalties or interest due under this title are referred to an  
15 attorney at law for collection **of a delinquent account after the assessment has**  
16 **become final**, an additional charge for attorney fees, in the amount of ten ~~per centum~~  
17 **percent** (10%) of the taxes, penalties and interest due, shall be paid by the ~~tax debtor~~  
18 **taxpayer.**

19 **B. The private counsel employed by the collector in accordance with this**  
20 **Section may be paid reasonable attorney fees and reasonable expenses out of**  
21 **current collections of the particular tax at issue. The reasonable attorney fees**  
22 **and reasonable expenses paid by the collector shall not exceed ten percent**  
23 **(10%) of the taxes, penalties, and interest recovered by the collector.**"
