Abstract: Provides relative to the exchange of surplus property of a police jury with private persons.

Present law defines "surplus property" as property deemed no longer needed for public purposes.

Present law authorizes certain dispositions of surplus property belonging to police juries.

Present law authorizes police juries to sell, lease, or exchange surplus property with political corporations of the state. Present law authorizes police juries to sell or lease (but not to exchange) surplus property to private persons. Proposed law authorizes police juries to sell, lease, or exchange surplus property with both political corporations and private persons.
