HB No. 802

Abstract: Directs the state treasurer to transfer monies among funds within the state treasury and abolishes the Insure La. Incentive Program Fund.

Present law establishes the Insure La. Incentive Program Fund in the state treasury. Provides that monies in the fund shall be appropriated and used solely and exclusively to make matching capital fund grants as provided by law. The fund shall consist of monies equal to the total amount of the tax credits, deductions, or rebates to individuals in La. enacted during the 2007 R.S., not to exceed the sum of \$100 million. At such time as the commissioner of insurance has finalized all of the grants authorized, the fund shall be abolished and any remaining unexpended and unencumbered balances shall revert to the state general fund.

Proposed law repeals present law. Further abolishes the fund and transfers any unexpended, unencumbered monies in the fund for deposit in and credit to the state general fund.

Authorizes and directs the state treasurer to deposit \$3,000,000 into the state general fund from the Incentive Fund.

Transfers monies to the state general fund from various fund appropriations reduced in the Deficit Reduction Plan approved by the governor by executive order and by action of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget on Jan. 9, 2009. Authorizes the transfer of \$24,378,056 to the state general fund in the following amounts from the following funds:

Authorizes and directs the state treasurer to deposit \$404,308 into the Overcollections Fund from the La. Technology Innovations Fund, notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary.

Authorizes and directs the state treasurer to deposit \$344,500,000 into the La. Medical

Assistance Trust Fund from FY 2008-2009 state general fund receipts.

Provides that monies in the Rapid Response Fund at the end of FY 2008-2009 shall not be included in the determination of the fund balance, requiring the state treasurer to deposit \$10 million into the fund on July 1, 2009.

Authorizes and directs the state treasurer to deposit \$13.5 million into the state general fund from the Rapid Response Fund, notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary.

All provisions of this Act shall become effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action, except that provisions for the transfer of monies from the Incentive Fund for deposit into the state general fund, provisions related to the Insure La. Incentive Program Fund, and provisions related to the Rapid Response Fund shall be effective on July 1, 2009.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to the original bill.

1. Deletes provisions amending the La. Mega-Project Development Fund (R.S. 51:2365(F))
2. Adds provisions repealing Insure La. Incentive Program Fund, abolishing the fund, and transferring monies in the fund to the state general fund.
3. Adds provision transferring \$13.5 million from the Rapid Response Fund to the state general fund.
