

1 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby urges
2 and requests the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to study charter school
3 use of city, parish, and other local public school system-owned facilities.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such study include the following:

5 (1) An examination of the financial and logistical effects of requiring a city, parish,
6 or other local public school system and a charter school to enter into a lease agreement with
7 subsequent rental payments, including situations in which a charter is subsequently revoked
8 or a charter school is moved to another building.

9 (2) An analysis of the practices of other states in relation to charter school use of
10 school system-owned facilities and the financial consequences.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State Board of Elementary and Secondary
12 Education submit a written report of its findings and conclusions, including any
13 recommendations for legislation relative to the issue, to the House Committee on Education
14 and the Senate Committee on Education not later than sixty days prior to the beginning of
15 the 2010 Regular Session.
