## DIGEST

Murray (SB 75)

Present law (R.S.33:101(1)) defines "master plan" as a statement of public policy for the physical development of a parish or municipality adopted by a parish or municipal planning commission.

Present law (R.S.33:108) provides the procedure for planning commissions to adopt a plan. Requires that prior to adoption there shall be at least one public hearing on the plan.

Proposed law requires voter approval prior to the implementation of a master plan which has the force of law in Orleans Parish.

Proposed law defines a "master plan which has the force of law" as any plan adopted by the governing authority which establishes policies, procedures, or strategies for the future growth and development of the parish.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
