Amendments proposed by Senator Donahue to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 268 by Senator Donahue

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 10, delete "final"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 2, line 2, after "**contesting the**" delete the remainder of the line, on line 3, delete  
5 "**notice of final assessment,**" and insert "**assessment within the time provided by law**" and  
6 delete "**one of**"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 2, at the end of line 6, after "suit" delete the remainder of the line, delete lines 7  
9 through 14, and insert:

10 **": however, the collector shall be permitted to file a reconventional demand**  
11 **against the taxpayer in such suit.**

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 2, line 15, change "**(3)(a)**" to "**C.(1)(a)**"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 5

15 On page 2, line 16, after "bond" insert "**or other security**"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 6

17 On page 2, line 17, after "bond" insert "**or other security**"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 7

19 On page 2, delete lines 19 through 23, and insert:

20 **"(b) The term "other security" as set forth in this Section shall include**  
21 **but not be limited to a pledge, collateral assignment, lien, mortgage, factoring**  
22 **of accounts receivable, or other encumbrance of assets.**

25 On page 3, line 2, change "**(c)**" to "**(3)**"

26 AMENDMENT NO. 9

27 On page 3, line 6, insert:

28 **"E: (4) If the taxpayer timely files the suit referred to herein, no collection**  
29 **action shall be taken in connection with the assessment of taxes, interest, and**  
30 **penalties, which are the subject of the taxpayer's suit, unless the taxpayer fails to post**  
31 **bond or other security or make the payment under protest required by the court;**  
32 **however, the collector shall be permitted to file a reconventional demand**  
33 **against the taxpayer in such suit.**

2 On page 3, line 10, change "D." to "(5)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 11

4 On page 3, line 18, after "Title." insert:

5 **"The private counsel employed by the collector in accordance with this Section**  
6 **may be paid reasonable attorney fees and reasonable expenses out of current**  
7 **collections of the particular tax at issue, not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the**  
8 **taxes, penalties, and interest recovered by the collector.**
