HB No. 546

Abstract: Authorizes the Vermilion Parish School Board to sell certain 16th section lands.

Proposed law authorizes the Vermilion Parish School Board to convey, transfer, assign, and deliver any interest, excluding mineral rights, the state or the school board may have to certain 16th section lands as described in proposed law. Further authorizes the school board to enter into such agreements, covenants, conditions, and stipulations and to execute such documents necessary to properly effectuate the delivery of complete title, excluding mineral rights, to such properties. Provides that such transfers shall be executed without an election and notwithstanding any provision of certain present law. Requires that proceeds of the sale of properties be deposited into the Dr. Daniel R. Dartez Educational Public Trust.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Education to the original bill.

1. Authorizes the school board to convey interest, excluding mineral rights, to a certain additional parcel of 16th section land.
2. Adds that transfers shall be executed without an election and notwithstanding any provision of present law.
3. Provides relative to agreements entered into and documents executed by and between the school board and the purchasers rather than between the school board and the apparent title holders of the property or their assigns, heirs, or legatees.
