**SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by Senator Martiny to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 152 by Senator Crowe

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1 line 4 after "definitions;" insert "to provide for notice;"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 13, after "**conduct**" and before the period insert "**provided that written**  
5 **notice has been given to the retailer pursuant to Subsection (D) of this Section**"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 2, between lines 18 and 19, insert the following:

8 **"D. When a complaint is received alleging that a retailer has sold or**  
9 **distributed goods, materials, or services to a person under the age of eighteen,**  
10 **which meets the definition of Paragraph (2) of Subsection (A) of this Section, the**  
11 **Attorney General's Public Protection Division, Consumer Protection Section,**  
12 **shall notify the retailer, in writing by certified mail, that a complaint has been**  
13 **made. The complaint shall include a brief description of the goods, materials,**  
14 **or services sold or distributed which served as the basis for the complaint and**  
15 **the date that the alleged sale or distribution occurred. The written notice shall**  
16 **also advise the retailer that five such complaints may subject the retailer to a**  
17 **formal investigation by the Consumer Protection Section to determine if an**  
18 **unfair or deceptive trade practice, pursuant to this Section, has occurred."**
