

**HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS**

House Bill No. 444 by Representative Perry

DWI: Provides with respect to administrative law hearings in DWI matters

**Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

1. Provides that an administrative hearing conducted after a person's driver's license has been suspended shall include matters relating to the legal rights of a person. Further provides that prehearing discovery in such matter shall be limited to requests for production of documents and depositions of non-law enforcement witnesses.

Present law provides that an administrative hearing conducted after a person's driver's license has been suspended shall cover certain issues including matters relating to the legal rights of the person.

Proposed law provides that an administrative hearing conducted after a person's driver's license has been suspended shall be limited to certain issues including matters relating to the legal rights of the person.

Proposed law provides for administrative hearing discovery in driver's license suspension cases be limited to requests for the production of documents and shall not include depositions of law enforcement witnesses.
