

(KEYWORD, SUMMARY, AND DIGEST as amended by Senate committee amendments)

LEVEES/TERREBONNE: Repeals the requirement of a distribution of a certain amount of millage revenues to the Atchafalaya Basin Levee District.

DIGEST

Present law provides that the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District shall not be exempt from taxation.

Proposed law retains present law but stipulates that all land, including mineral rights, in the possession of the Atchafalaya Basin Levee District in Terrebonne Parish for the purposes of ownership and maintenance and operation of the Atchafalaya Basin Levee District be reverted back to the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District.

Present law requires the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District to remit to the Atchafalaya Basin Levee District 10% of the ad valorem taxes collected in the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District.

Proposed law repeals present law.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to the original bill.

- 1. Stipulates that all land in the possession of the Atchafalaya Basin Levee District in Terrebonne Parish for the purposes of ownership and maintenance and operation of the Atchafalaya Basin Levee District be reverted back to the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works to the engrossed bill.

- 1. Requires the mineral rights to be transferred along with the property.
