
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 235 by Senator N. Gautreaux

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "to provide" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 3 in its
 3 entirety and on line 4, delete "appointment; to provide for the method of appointment and"
 4 and insert "relative to the appointment and election of the chief of police of the town; to
 5 provide"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 1, at the beginning of line 5, insert "qualifications,"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 13, after "~~(29)~~" and before "Notwithstanding" insert "(a)"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, delete lines 14 through 17 in their entirety and on page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 in
 12 their entirety and insert in lieu thereof "**chief of police of the town of Duson shall be**
 13 **elected or appointed as provided in R.S. 33:381.2. The term of the chief of police shall**
 14 **be**"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 5

16 On page 2, line 6, after "**office.**" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 7 and 8 in
 17 their entirety and insert the following:

18 **"(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the**
 19 **chief of police of the town of Duson shall have two years of full time law**
 20 **enforcement experience and shall successfully complete a certified training**
 21 **program approved by the Council on Peace Officers Standards and Training.**
 22 **In addition the chief shall successfully pass a council approved comprehensive**
 23 **examination within one calendar year from the date of initial employment as**
 24 **chief of police.**

25 **(c) The mayor shall, in accordance with ordinances adopted by the**
 26 **board of aldermen, supervise and direct the administration of the office of chief**
 27 **of police, and the chief shall report directly to the mayor.**"
