Subject: Per Diem Increase for Commissioners

Provides relative to per diem paid to commissioners of Waterworks District #8 of Calcasieu Parish

Purpose of Bill: Allows the governing authority of Calcasieu Parish to authorize the treasurer of Waterworks District #8 to pay the commissioners of the district a per diem not to exceed \$100 for attending meetings of the board.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

This bill may increase local fund expenditures \$7,200 annually for the Calcasieu Parish Waterworks District #8.

The proposed bill provides for an increase in per diem paid to each commissioner from \$60 to \$100 for each board meeting attended. The district holds meetings 12 times annually. R.S. 33:3819 provides a maximum of 24 board meetings each year plus 12 special meetings for a total of 36 maximum meetings.

Currently the district consists of 5 commissioners who receive \$60 for attending district meetings. Assuming the boards meet the statutorily maximum number of times, the current maximum per diem payable would be \$10,800. Per diem paid to the commissioners provided by this bill (\$100) may total \$18,000 annually. Therefore the proposed legislation may increase expenditures \$7,200 annually (\$18,000 - \$10,800).

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
