PLANNING/ZONING. Provides relative to the membership of transportation policy committee of certain metropolitan planning organizations. (8/15/09)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Requires that the membership of the transportation policy committee of the MPO for any metropolitan area include voting members from each parish within the metropolitan area rather than from each municipality or unincorporated portion of a parish within the metropolitan area.
2. Technical amendment.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

Proposed law requires that the membership of the transportation policy committee of the metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for any metropolitan area include voting members from each parish within the metropolitan area. Additionally requires the membership to be as proportionate as possible to provide equal representation.

Proposed law defines a metropolitan area as an area which encompasses a parish with a consolidated, home rule charter government with a population between 150,000-400,000 persons based on the latest federal decennial census.

Effective August 15, 2009.
