

Prior law provided that the Louisiana Real Estate Commission consists of nine members appointed by the governor. Prior law provided that one member is to be appointed from each of the seven supreme court districts and two members are to be appointed at large.

New law provides for two additional appointees; one appointee shall be selected from either the Fourth Congressional District or the Fifth Congressional District and one appointee shall be selected from either the First, Second, Third, Sixth, or Seventh Congressional District. New law otherwise retains prior law.

Prior law provided that effective the second Monday in January 1992, appointees to the commission serve staggered terms of two, four, or six years, and that upon expiration of these initial terms, all appointees will serve six year terms. New law deletes references to these initial staggered terms and provides that each appointee to the commission will serve only one six-year term. New law otherwise retains prior law.
