AN ACT

To enact R.S. 49:213.4(A)(9), relative to Louisiana Coastal Protection, Conservation,
Restoration and Management; to provide for certain powers and duties of the Coastal
Protection and Restoration Authority; to authorize the authority to enter into certain
agreements with parish governing authorities; to provide certain terms and
conditions of the agreements; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 49:213.4(A)(9) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§213.4. Powers and duties

A. The authority shall:

* * *

**(9) Have the power to enter into any agreement with a parish governing
authority located wholly or partially within the coastal area but which is not
part of a levee district for the construction, operation, maintenance, repair,
rehabilitation, or replacement of any coastal protection, conservation and
restoration, hurricane protection, infrastructure, storm damage reduction, or**

1 flood control project. The authority shall have the power to provide in the
 2 agreement for the use and exercise by the parish governing authority of any and
 3 all powers of levee districts or levee and drainage districts.
