

Directs all local governing authorities and public emergency service providers to cease assessing accident response fees or any similar assessment against persons utilizing emergency services and expresses intent of the legislature that such charges are contrary to state law. Further directs specified associations of local governments and local officials to inform their respective members that the legislature believes that the practice is prohibited. Provides that the Resolution does not preclude charging for medical care, including medical transportation, that would ordinarily be the patients responsibility nor charging for emergency services if the user's actions created an unusual and extraordinary expense on the part of the responder. Requests that the legislative auditor report to the legislature on any governing authority or emergency service provider that is imposing such charges.
