

Prior law provided certain enumerated powers and duties of the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority (CPRA).

New law retains prior law and adds the power to enter into any agreement with a parish governing authority located wholly or partially within the coastal area but which is not part of a levee district for the construction, operation, maintenance, repair, rehabilitation, or replacement of any coastal protection, conservation and restoration, hurricane protection, infrastructure, storm damage reduction, or flood control project. Further adds that the CPRA has the power to provide in the agreement for the use and exercise by the parish governing authority of any and all powers of levee districts or levee and drainage districts.
