

Existing law defines "surplus property" as property deemed no longer needed for public purposes. Authorizes certain dispositions of surplus property belonging to police juries.

Existing law authorizes police juries to sell, lease, or exchange surplus property with political corporations of the state. Existing law authorizes police juries to sell or lease (but not to exchange) surplus property to private persons. New law authorizes police juries to exchange surplus property with private persons.

Effective August 15, 2009.
