

Existing law authorizes the governing authority of any parish having a population in excess of 325,000 persons, the parish of Orleans excepted, to dispose of immovable property owned by the parish or property to which the title is in the public, including streets, roads, and alleys, that is no longer needed for public use. Provides that existing law applies to St. Tammany Parish and the city of Slidell. Provides further with respect to the method of disposition.

New law authorizes the municipalities in Jefferson Parish to dispose of any such property.

Effective August 15, 2009.
