

New law requires the board of commissioners of any economic development district composed of at least 13 voting members, located in any parish with a population of not more than 104,000 and not less than 98,000 persons, and whose boundaries are coterminous with the boundaries of the parish to meet in regular session quarterly and to also meet in special session as often as the president of the board convenes them or on the written request of five members.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 16, 2009).
