

Existing law requires the principal of every public elementary or secondary school to provide for the transfer of education records of any student who was enrolled at his school upon the written request of any authorized person on behalf of an educational facility operated within any correctional or health facility, whether within or outside La., where such student has become enrolled or is seeking enrollment. New law additionally provides for the same requirement for principals upon such request on behalf of a public or nonpublic elementary or secondary school, whether within or outside La., where a current or former student has become enrolled or is seeking enrollment.

Existing law requires such transferred records to include dates and reasons for expulsion if a student has been expelled. New law additionally requires such records to include dates and reasons for suspension if a student has been suspended.

Effective August 15, 2009.
