
The original instrument and the following digest, which constitutes no part of the legislative instrument, were prepared by Curry Johnson.

DIGEST

Present law requires the commissioner to adopt rules and regulations setting forth the requirements for the raising, slaughtering, and sale of imported exotic deer and antelope, elk, and farm-raised white tail deer for commercial purposes.

Proposed law retains present law and further requires the commissioner to adopt rules and regulations for other exotic cervidae.

Present law requires persons who raise or sell imported exotic deer and antelope, elk, and farm-raised white tail deer, for commercial purposes, on breeding farms or propagating preserves of which he is the owner or lessee to apply for a license.

Proposed law retains present law but further requires persons who raise or sell other exotic cervidae to apply for a license.

Proposed law requires the commissioner to adopt rules and regulations regarding fencing requirements for exotic cervidae.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
