Abstract: Allows agencies which operate a child support program under Title IV-D of the Social Security Act in states other than La. to place a levy or lien directly on assets held by La. financial institutions without requiring said agencies to obtain a court order first.

Present law allows the Dept. of Social Services to place a lien on an obligor's assets held by a La. financial institution.

Proposed law retains present law and allows Title IV-D child support agencies from other states to place a levy or lien directly on assets held by an obligor in a La. financial institution without requiring a court order.

Proposed law defines "Title IV-D agency".
