WILDLIFE & FISHERIES SEC: Authorizes the secretary of the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to develop certification standards for Louisiana wild fish and seafood including wild-caught shrimp

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 56:578.15, relative to a state certification program for Louisiana wild fish; to
3 authorize the secretary of the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to establish such
4 program; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 56:578.15 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §578.15. Louisiana Wild Seafood Certification Program

8 A. The secretary of the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries is authorized
9 to establish a quality certification program for Louisiana wild fish, as defined in R.S.
10 56:8, and for Louisiana wild seafood products, including wild-caught shrimp, which
11 are taken, harvested, or landed in Louisiana. The program shall be established
12 through the promulgation and adoption of certification standards in accordance with
13 the Administrative Procedure Act. Such standards may include but are not limited
14 to harvest requirements, post-harvest refrigeration requirements, quality standards,
15 handling practices, traceability, branding and branding registrations, recording
16 requirements, compliance standards, and packaging regulations. The secretary may
17 develop and regulate certification protocols, programs, and establish regulatory
18 authority in cooperation with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry,

1 Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals, Louisiana State University, and any
2 other state or federal agency deemed appropriate.

3 B. All seafood product intended to be marketed as Louisiana Wild Seafood
4 certified must meet all criteria and requirements as set out in the department's rules
5 and regulations. Any product sold or attempted to be sold under the auspices of the
6 Louisiana Wild Seafood Certification Program which is in violation of the rules and
7 regulations shall be immediately removed from the market and the disposition of
8 such product shall be delineated in the rules and regulations adopted to establish the
9 program.

10 C. Any fisherman or seafood dealer who wishes to participate in the
11 Louisiana Wild Seafood Certification Program shall apply to the department to be
12 issued a participation permit by the department. This permit may be suspended or
13 revoked by the department for violation of the provisions of the program. Any
14 holder of such permit who harvests or markets Louisiana wild fish or wild seafood
15 products in accordance with the requirements of the Louisiana Wild Seafood
16 Certification Program shall be authorized to market said product under the auspices
17 of the Louisiana Wild Seafood Certification Program.

Abstract: Authorizes the secretary of the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to establish a certification program for Louisiana wild fish.

Proposed law authorizes the secretary of the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to establish a quality certification program for Louisiana wild fish and wild seafood products, including wild-caught shrimp, which are taken, harvested, or landed in Louisiana. Requires promulgation of certification standards which may include harvest requirements, post-harvest refrigeration requirements, quality standards, handling practices, traceability, branding and branding registrations, recording requirements, compliance standards, and packaging regulations. Further authorizes the secretary to develop and regulate certification protocols, programs, and establish regulatory authority in cooperation with the Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals, Louisiana State University, and any other state or federal agency deemed appropriate.

Provides that all seafood product intended to be marketed as Louisiana Wild Seafood certified must meet all criteria and requirements as set out in the department's rules and regulations. Any product sold or attempted to be sold under the auspices of the program which does not meet the standards will be removed from the market and disposed of in the manner delineated in the rules

Requires any fisherman or seafood dealer wishing to participate in the program to apply to the department for a participation permit. Such permit may be suspended or revoked by the department for violation of the provisions of the program. Such permit authorizes anyone who harvests or markets Louisiana wild fish or wild seafood products in accordance with the requirements of the Louisiana Wild Seafood Certification Program to market said product under the auspices of the program.
