DIGEST

Present law provides that the district attorneys of this state, the parish of Orleans excepted, shall be entitled to an expense allowance for salaries of stenographers, clerks and secretaries, and salaries or charges for special officers, investigators and other employees and an expense allowance for stationery forms, telephone, transportation, travel, postage, hotel and other expenses incurred in the discharge of their official duties.

Present law further provides that the police juries of the various parishes of the state are authorized to pay from their general fund any of the items of expense, as provided for in the present law, incurred by the several district attorneys of this state when acting in their official capacities.

Proposed law retains present law and adds that notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the district attorney in the Sixteenth Judicial District shall not expend any funds under his control, or seek funding or reimbursement from any source, to pay expenses or costs for registration and attendance at continuing legal education programs by office personnel.

Effective August 15, 2010.
