
The original instrument and the following digest, which constitutes no part of the legislative instrument, were prepared by J. W. Wiley.

DIGEST

Present law requires that no person can hunt with a firearm unless that person has first been issued a certificate of satisfactory completion of a firearm and hunter education course taught or approved by the DW&F, or possesses a valid hunting license issued by the DW&F. Further provides for exemptions from this requirement.

Proposed law provides an exemption for any person who is accompanied and is under direct supervision by his parent, step parent, grandparent or step grandparent with a valid hunting license or proof of successful completion of a hunter safety education course approved by the DW&F.

Present law provides that application for a certain exemption must be filed in person at the DW&F main office building in Baton Rouge, or at any other location designated by the DW&F.

Proposed law provides that no application is required for the exemption for any person who is accompanied and is under direct supervision by his parent, step parent, grandparent or step grandparent with a valid hunting license or proof of successful completion of a hunter safety education course approved by the DW&F.

Provides that this Act will be known as "The Louisiana Family Hunting Law."
