**Abstract:** Allow persons seventeen years of age and under to obtain a special identification card without a parental or guardian signature.

Present law provides that identifying information and documents required to obtain a special identification card are the same as those required to obtain a license.

Proposed law provides that for persons 17 and under, the signature of a parent or guardian shall not be required, provided the applicant has the proper identifying information and documents.
