DIGEST

With regard to the TOPS-Tech Award, present law requires a student graduating from high school during the 2000-2001 school year and thereafter to have a composite score on the ACT of 17 or higher or an equivalent condordant value on any enhanced or revised version of such test or on the SAT.

Proposed law retains present law requirement, but also includes, as an alternative eligibility requirement, beginning with any student graduating from high school during the 2010-2011 school year and thereafter, the attainment of a silver level score on the assessment of the ACT WorkKeys system.

Effective July 1, 2010.
