DIGEST

Proposed law prohibits impoundment of a private passenger car, pickup truck, van, recreational vehicle, or motorcycle stopped while being operated by a Louisiana resident by a law enforcement officer where such vehicle or operator, or both, present no imminent danger to the public.

Proposed law provides that an operator who is a resident of Louisiana shall be issued a notice of non-compliance and allowed to proceed. Provides further that a law enforcement officer may remove the license plate from a private passenger car, pickup truck, van, recreational vehicle, or motorcycle.

Proposed law defines "imminent danger to the public as" a present and apparent danger to the life, health, safety or property of the public.

Effective August 15, 2010.
